

BIANCA'S STORY: BRAZIL

The doors of the Rescue Project have been open for 6 months, impacting children aged 4-14 years of age. Sowing the Word of God and showing the love of God in a practical way. Over this short period of time we have gotten to know each and every child and youth that attend the project.

Bianca comes from a very needy family who live in the interior. The interior is what we call the area outside the city boundaries of Maues. Maues is the interior of the capital Manaus, and the houses located on the riverbanks or forming small communities are classified as the interior by those living in Maues. Bianca and her family are from the 'interior' and are very needy. Bianca arrived at the Rescue Project showing very anti-social behaviour; hitting and attacking her classmates. Over the years we have become accustomed to the fact that what happens to children in their 'home' life spills over into the classroom.

Bianca was very introverted and often missed classes but Joilson, her teacher, explained that there has been radical change in Bianca, "Bianca has become a model pupil, wanting to study, arriving early to school, hungry to learn, as well as this her whole demeanour and behaviour has changed, it is amazing what the love of God can do in transforming a little life."
